Our Focus

The vision for our intern program can be summed up into three categories:

1. Intimacy with Christ: we desire our interns to cultivate a rich relationship with the Lord Jesus.
2. Exposure to cross-cultural ministry: through day-to-day life at the Abraham Project and local community.
3. Knowledge of God's will: our hope is that our interns will leave with a better understanding of God's calling and will for their lives.

What Our Interns Do

Our interns' time here at the Abraham Project can be divided into the following three facets:

1. Spiritual Development: this takes place during one-on-one discipleship sessions, group prayer, and Bible study with the intern coordinators, other missionaries, and fellow interns.
2. Ministry: primarily in our children's homes, daycare center, and facilitating our short-term teams with on-site construction as well as outreaches in the community.
3. Fun: although our interns work a lot, they also enjoy the culture, people, and sites of Costa Rica!

Where Our Interns Live

Our interns live near the Abraham Project with local families from Lighthouse Christian Community Church. Each host family is chosen based on their geographical location, ability to provide quality care for our interns, and quality of character.
